P. Diddy Implicated In Two Murders By Former Associate

Rap mogul Sean "P. Diddy" Combs has been going to great lengths to refine his bad boy image. The mogul is slated to run the New York Marathon on November 2 to raise funds for educational charities, but several allegations made by a former friend and partner could damage the mogul's image beyond repair.

Kirk Burrowes, former president of Bad Boy Entertainment, has filed a \$25 million lawsuit against Combs.

In the lawsuit, Burrowes implicates Combs in the death of Suge Knight's bodyguard, Jai "Big Jake" Hassan, and in the death of rap star Tupac Shakur, according to the New York Post.

In sworn testimony, Burrowes accused Combs of building his Bad Boy organization "to gain power, recognition, fame, and financial gain through acts and threats involving murder, mayhem, and extortion via the enterprise."

Burrowes' testimony implicated Combs in the death of Suge Knight's bodyguard, Jai "Big Jake" Hassan, "With the consent, approval and ratification of the enterprise, Suge Knight's chief bodyguard Big Jake was murdered in 1995."

Hassan was murdered in Atlanta during the height of the East Coast versus West Coast feud between Knight's Death Row Records and Combs' Bad Boy Records.

Combs' close associate Anthony "Wolf" Jones was identified by a local deputy sheriff as the shooter, but the deputy sheriff was later killed in a car accident.

Jones was with Combs and young rapper Shyne's co-defendant in 2001, when the three stood trial for the infamous December 1999 Club New York shooting.

Jones and Combs were acquitted of assault and weapons charges, while Shyne was found guilty of assault and sentenced to 10 years behind bars.

Burrowes also says in his sworn testimony that Bad Boy Entertainment was suspected to have hired the shooter who shot Tupac Shakur, Death Row Records' biggest star, in 1996.

The suit also accuses Combs of bursting into Burrowes' office in 1996 and brandishing a baseball bat to intimidate Burrowes into signing over his 25 percent stake in Bad Boy to Combs.

Burrowes--who is godfather to the rap mogul's son, Justin--says that P. Diddy later apologized and said he'd make good on their original deal, but never did. Burrowes also accused Combs of causing Mary J. Blige to fire him as her manager.

Burrowes also claims that Combs had songwriter John Bentley of Philadelphia intimidated, "John Bentley was threatened with a pistol Jan. 31, 2002...was shot near his home in Philadelphia in September 2002 and stalked by telephone and in person by thugs hired by Combs in Atlanta."

Combs' attorney Benjamin Brafman responded to the allegations, "This is one of the many entirely baseless lawsuits that Mr. Combs and other superstars like him must contend with on a regular basis."

Burrowes' attorney John Bostany explained that his client is only seeking justice, "My client appears to be the victim of a corrupt group that 'thugs its way through it' and I am here to help him get justice."
